MISSING WOMAN URGED TO COME FORWARD

Police are urging a woman who has been reported missing in Ipswich to come forward so they can be reassured that she is safe and well.

A friend of Paula Clennell reported that he was concerned as he hadn't seen her since Saturday night (December 9).

Paula, aged 24, is believed to work as a prostitute in Ipswich.

Detective Chief Superintendent Stewart Gull, head of Suffolk Constabulary's Crime Management Department, said: "As a result of the publicity surrounding these cases, we have received calls concerning people thought to be missing who have subsequently turned up safe and well.

"We know that Paula uses a number of addresses in Ipswich and we are currently checking these to establish her whereabouts.

"We would urge Paula or anyone who knows of her whereabouts to call us immediately so we can reassure that she is safe and well."
