Identifying fraud risks



Identifying fraud risks is at the heart of our action to prevent fraud. Fraud risk is considered via:



- Regular business operation assessments and risk workshops
- The Anti-Fraud Group (AFG) which is the principal body for coordinating the anti-fraud strategy of the BBC including our commercial subsidiaries and World Service
- Internal audits
- External audit
- The use of data analytics technology over systems such as payroll and expenses

Our identification of fraud risks and implementation of controls to prevent them is an ongoing process and considered whenever new business ventures or jurisdictions are entered into. The process is supported by relevant training.

You also have a role to play in identifying risks by reporting concerns or suspicious activity.
