Dodgy territory

Always:

- Ensure the business carried out meets local laws and regulations
- Obtain confirmation from third parties that they are able to remit money to the BBC in accordance with local laws
- Report any suspicions you have about the appropriateness of the conduct of a third party to an appropriate person of authority

Never:

- Accept or handle cash on behalf of the BBC or another party
- Accept monies from a third party unrelated to the transaction
- Pass on sensitive information
- Utilise complex transaction routes to attempt to avoid local bureaucracy
