Dear Mr Solomons,

Further to my letter dated 9 July 2009, I have now spoken to Orange, my then mobile network provider.

Orange has informed me that to its certain knowledge there were in December 2003 at least three attempts unlawfully to intercept my communications through my mobile phone, number

As a matter of urgency I would like to know the following information.

Firstly, in relation to the piece of evidence you have referred to: what kind of piece of paper is it? Does it have a crest or watermark? Is it attached to any other pieces of paper? Is it included in a book or notepad? Is there any other writing on the same sheet or on any other sheets attached to it? Are there any other names on the same sheet of paper or on any accompanying papers? If so do they include the names of anyone that you know to have had their mobile phones intercepted? Do the words 'editor', 'deputy editor' or the names of any editorial staff at the News of the World appear on the same sheet of paper or any accompanying sheets? Are there any notations on the piece/s of paper of any kind? Is my name and/or number handwritten, and if so, whose handwriting is it in? If it is word-processed, on what computer was it produced? Where was the evidence recovered?

Secondly, I would be grateful if you could do a further search to see if any additional information that might relate to me or to information contained on my mobile is contained or referred to in the material you hold. That would include any of the following addresses where I have lived in:

It would also include my mobile number:  And the names of people who are personally close to me, including Stephen Whitehead, Jamie Arkell, Rees Bryant and Rhodri Bryant.

I realise that this is a substantial piece of work but I would be grateful if I could have this information as soon as possible.

I would of course be happy to meet to discuss this.
