

Your complaint

I refer to your letter of 28 September addressed to John Ryley. As a preliminary, please note that Mr Ryley does not work for News Corporation, and that Sky News is not part of News Corporation. It is not clear whether you assert that it was Sky News or News Corporation that intercepted your voice messages, but to be clear, this response is written on behalf of Sky News. If your complaint is concerned with the activities of News Corporation, you will need to write separately to them.

We take allegations such as those raised in your letter extremely seriously, not least because Sky News has not been the subject of any accusation of phone hacking prior to your letter. We are not aware of any incidents of telephone hacking by any Sky journalists at any time. Nevertheless, we naturally wish to investigate fully the matters you have brought to our attention. As such, we would be obliged if you could provide full detail and supporting evidence of:

- 1. the basis for your belief that your voicemail was intercepted,
- 2. the dates and times on which you allege the hacking occurred,
- 3. the identity of any journalist or journalists you allege were responsible,
- 4. the specific dates and times of the messages you say you sent to the Sky News' text message number, and
- 5. any other relevant information or evidence that you hold which might assist us in investigating this matter.

If you are concerned by the events that you allege in your letter, you may wish to take legal advice and bring them to the attention of the police. You should also be aware that as part of our ongoing assistance to the Leveson Inquiry, we have provided a copy of your letter and this response to that Inquiry.
