I was disappointed to see the headline that you gave to the PCC's adjudication against the News of the World, published on the 18th February.

The Code of Practice says that, when criticised, editors must publish adjudications 'in full and with due prominence, including headline reference to the PCC'. The fact that the PCC was not mentioned in the headline to this latest ruling therefore constitutes a further breach of the Code.

I was particularly surprised at this oversight given the current context of renewed scrutiny of self-regulation.

Perhaps you could let me know how you intend to remedy this.
