It has been a time of some change for the PCC and the newspaper industry, and there are currently a number of challenges for media regulators posed by new technologies and convergence. We think that the PCC's structure and approach – flexibility, independence, the co-operation of the regulated industry, and the application of principles rather than prescriptive rules - are well suited to the new landscape.
