PCC Glasgow seminar – 5th December 2006

I am writing to let you know about a PCC seminar which will be held in Glasgow on 5th December. It would be excellent if you could send some of your colleagues to the event, and it would of course be very good to see you there too if you were free.

The idea is to bring people up to date with the Commission's thinking on a number of subjects including news gathering techniques, pictures and privacy, and the application of the Code in areas such as payments to criminals and witnesses. We have previously held seminars in London for news, picture and features editors, and have been encouraged by the response to offer more seminars.
