News Corp/BSkyB Merger

I refer to the Secretary of State's statement of 25th January.

I write on behalf of BT, Guardian Media Group, Associated Newspapers Limited, Trinity Mirror Plc, Northcliffe Media and Telegraph Media Group (together the "Concerned Parties").

In his statement, the Secretary of State concludes (consistent with Ofcom's advice) that the merger would give rise to plurality issues which warrant investigation by the Competition Commission.

The Secretary of State then sets in motion a process under which OFT and Ofcom are asked to explore possible "undertakings in lieu" with News Corp and to report to the Secretary of State on whether such undertakings would be effective to address "the potential impact of media plurality".

The Secretary of State only proposes to go out to public consultation however, after he has provisionally decided (in the light of the advice from OFT and Ofcom) to accept such undertakings.

In order to ensure that the overall process is both fair and thorough, it will therefore be critical for Ofcom/OFT and the Secretary of State to consult with key industry players (including the Concerned Parties) ahead of the provisional decision.

The Concerned Parties stand ready to take part in this earlier consultation and to provide such assistance as would be helpful.

In advance of which, it would be very helpful to understand better how each of Ofcom and OFT see their respective roles and the timing for next steps.
