

PCC Open Day in Leeds

Following on from the success of previous public events the Press Complaints Commission is holding an Open Day on Tuesday 19 February 2008 in the Albert Room at Leeds Town Hall.

The day will consist of two sessions:

1) Surgery 2.30 – 3.45pm

The surgery session is designed for members of the public who want to have a private, informal chat with a senior member of PCC staff about making a complaint to a newspaper or magazine.

2) Question and Answer session from 4pm

The Q&A session is designed for members of the public to put their questions on all aspects of the press to a panel of individuals who have considerable experience of the PCC. The panel will include the PCC Chairman, Sir Christopher Meyer, PCC Director Tim Toulmin, a lay Commission member and a representative of the newspaper industry.

Leeds will be the tenth city that the PCC has visited since it began its series of public meetings in 2003. These meetings provide an excellent opportunity for people from all sections of the community to find out about the work of the PCC at first-hand, and we have received some very good feedback from participants at previous meetings.
